The following rules comprise the “Code of Conduct”.

All Albury-Wodonga Football Association representative players must comply with these rules at all times; both on and off the field.

Players who fail to comply with these rules may:

Be returned to their parents/guardians, at the parents/guardians expense and, or

Be excluded from further participation in the Albury Wodonga Football Association representative program and, or

Be the subject of disciplinary action as determined by the Albury Wodonga Football Association executive committee

Conduct outside these rules will not be tolerated.

- All players selected for an Albury Wodonga Football Association representative team must make themselves available for all competitions in which that team participates.
- The use or possession of cigarettes, alcohol or any other substance classified as a drug of addiction and not prescribed by a medical practitioner is prohibited.
- Carry out all reasonable instructions as provided by the team coach, Team Manager or Albury Wodonga Football Association executive member.
- Play by the rules.
- Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your captain, coach or Team manager approach the official during or after the competition.
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable or permitted behaviors in any sport.
- Work equally hard for yourself and or your team. Your team’s performance will benefit, so will you.
- Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they are made by your team or the opposition.
- Treat all participants in your sport as you like to be treated. Do not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor.
- Cooperate with your coach, teammates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
- Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please parents and coaches.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
